Develop a plan for your county rural fire fighting water supply

- Identify high risk areas
- Prioritize sites for accessibility
- Standardize equipment - hydrant coupling

Selecting sites for hydrants

- Install as part of new pond construction
- Good access for fire trucks
- Water supply deep enough for year round use (ice in winter can limit use on shallow ponds)
- Install on existing ponds with adequate depth and access
- Installation on lakes may require permits and permanent easement
